DESCRIPTION OF INDICATOR	<p><b><u>Definition:</u> Share of the population with completed higher or postgraduate education</b></p> <p>The computation of this indicator is based on data from the census and the Labour Force Survey; cross-values: age, highest attained formal education,</p> <p>Problems: census data are only available every 10 years. The results of the Labour Force Survey are estimates based on a sample. Data for the 1993-2005 period are not methodologically comparable with the 1991 and 2002 census data.</p> <p><u>Detailed methodological explanations:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>– SORS: Rapid Reports, Labour Market – Labour Force Survey Results</li> </ul> <p><u>International comparability:</u> difficult due to different education systems</p> <p><u>Manner of presentation:</u> aggregately for the whole economy; by region; surveys and comparisons usually cover the population aged 25 or over, working-age population aged 25-64, or the total labour force.</p> <p><u>Unit of measurement:</u> %</p>
