	To calculate the indicator, we use data from regular annual statistical surveys from: (i) the ŠOL-KP form, which is filled in by vocational schools and higher education institutions; (ii) data from the enrolment sheets filled in by students enrolled in higher education institutions; (iii) the ŠOL-ŠTUD questionnaire filled in by students enrolled in vocational colleges and higher education institutions. Cross-values: students, teaching staff.
